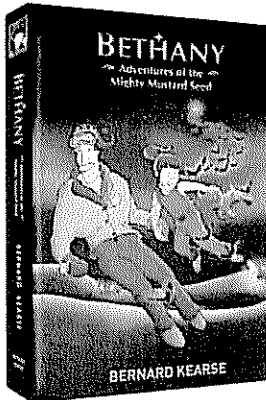


BETHANY
